

## **Memorial Scholarship Award (2024)**

## **History**

The Aurora American Legion Band's Memorial Scholarship Award was started in 1974. It was created in memory of long-time band member and past band president Leon Haring, a baritone player. Mr. Haring's wife, Nancy, initially funded the award on behalf of her husband; today the award is funded solely by the band.

Since 1974, over \$19,000 has been awarded to 85 members of the band to provide assistance for educational opportunities. Awardees are chosen on the basis of participation, service, musicianship, improvement, leadership, patriotism, and spirit. The band is proud that many of the awardees are still with the band today.

The band recognizes the value in nurturing continued participation in music. We hope to encourage a lifelong interest in music and performing that extends well beyond high school and college, and to continue to be an outlet for that in the Fox Valley.

The Memorial Scholarship Award application is open to band members currently enrolled in college for the following semester and who have completed at least one year of college.
